

Greater Nottingham Transformation Partnership

The Greater Nottingham Transformation Partnership aims to improve the health of people living in the city and south of the county by bringing together all the health and social care services in the area under a new system.

This will mean services working in a more joined-up way to ensure patients receive more holistic care, treatment and advice overall.

The changes are more about the way health and care agencies work together than about the way patients access services. Healthcare agencies will have clearer incentives to improve the health and wellbeing of the local population.



Significant work is currently being undertaken to scope what this future model will look like in Nottingham, and we intend to start a conversation with clinicians, stakeholders and local people as proposals start to take shape.

The Greater Nottingham Transformation Partnership covers four Clinical Commissioning Groups – Nottingham City CCG, Nottingham North and East CCG, Nottingham West CCG and Rushcliffe CCG – as well as all the health and social care organisations that provide services in the patch.
